### **All Region Auditions: Saturday October 29, 2016**

Where: Elmwood Middle School 16100 S. 13<sup>th</sup> Street Rogers, AR 72756

All students must ride the bus to the event. ASBOA state rules

Departure: 7:15 am from FAYETTEVILLE HIGH SCHOOL (arrive by 7:00 am)

Dress: Orchestra t-shirts and jeans

Snacks and lunch items can be purchased on site. Students may of course bring their own food. Also I would suggest for them to bring a book, games or cards to play as it can be a very long day. (students must be responsible for these items)

Students will be given an audition time upon arrival (not before). If you would like for your child to leave after their last audition, you may pick them up. We will need a note in advance from you and for your child to visually check out with our chaperones. (Students must be picked up by a parent or designated legal guardian.)

Arrival back to FHS: 7:00 pm (tentative)

Ms. Sandven and Mr. Yale will receive music for those students who are chosen to be in an all-region orchestra at the end of the day. Students chosen will be given extra help in learning this music.

The clinics (rehearsals) are on Friday evening and Saturday morning November 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>. The performances will be in the afternoon of November 12<sup>th</sup>. The clinics and performances will be held at Bentonville High School.

*Every student is expected to respect our chaperones and their rules. If this is not the case, the child's parents will be called and expected to drive to Rogers to pick up the student.*

## **ALL-REGION AUDITION INFORMATION**

7:30-8:30 Registration (Mr. Yale and Ms. Sandven)

Students look up their randomly pre-assigned audition time and warm-up in the cafeteria.

7:45 am Director's meeting

8:30 am Try-out material and scales posted

9:00 am First auditions begin

Students will play prepared pieces first (in whatever order the student chooses), then scales (in the order listed), and then sight reading (if required) Scales must be performed by memory, and must be performed in the order posted. Students will be given 20 seconds to look over the sight-reading material.

**No talking in the audition room.**

**No warm-up will be allowed in the tryout room.**

A student who misses their audition time will receive a 5% deduction of their overall score, and will be allowed to audition at the next available time, which may not be until the end of the audition day.

These rules are in place to help insure that each child has a fair audition.

Our students are to be congratulated on their hard work in their preparation for these auditions.
